Sourced from the Karridale sub-region in Margaret River in the cool south of the district.

A leaner style of Chardonnay, with background oak and bright energy.

Harvest:	March 19, 2020
Clones:	Clone 95 80%, Gin Gin 20%
Vinification:	100% barrel maturation – 7 months in 5% new and 95% used French puncheons Battonage
Bottled:	November 2020
Alcohol:	12.5 % vol
pH:	3.2

VA:	0.48 g/L
RS:	0.58 g/L

But, what does it taste like?

Restrained and energetic, with white flowers and a mineral accent. Subtle stonefruit flavours in tandem with background oak and a spine of citrusy acidity bringing line and length to the deal.
